SENIOR RESEARCH FELLOW, Contemporary Chinese Society

CERI is a social sciences research center dedicated to international studies. The topics on which it focuses are: the historical trajectories of States, political violence, migration, the politics of identity, the interaction between States and markets, international security and foreign affairs.

The successful applicant will join a team of 50+ scholars with various disciplinary backgrounds, including international relations, comparative political sociology, international political economy, political anthropology and area studies.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Research on Chinese contemporary society with a focus on the interaction between society and politics in China. Applicants must demonstrate knowledge of social sciences and their methodology, and the ability to conduct collaborative research.

Teaching courses on contemporary China at Sciences Po, at both the undergraduate and graduate level.

Supervision of PhD students.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Doctoral degree in political science, sociology or anthropology; PhD dissertation topic related to contemporary Chinese society
- Ability to supervise PhD research
- Minimum ten-year experience in research and teaching on contemporary China
- Fluency in written and spoken Mandarin;
- Good level of French and English. For non-French candidates, a passive knowledge of French is a minimum requirement.
